VIGNO: Vino with the latin G from Carignan. Wines made by various producers of an appellation concept of dry-farmed old vines from Maule that rescue long-held traditions and age-old Carignan.

The Carignan used to make this wine comes from 55-year-old dry-farmed, bush-trained vines near Mejozal. The characteristics of the old vines and the soil provide us with balanced fruit that in turn allows us to make tremendously balanced and interesting wines.
