PINOT NOIR 2018 CASABLANCA

This wine comes from the Kingston vineyard, located in Las Dichas, one of the coolest sectors in the Casablanca Valley. Its vines grow on the soft rolling hills of the Coastal Mountains, widely known for its granitic soils with a presence of red clays. In addition to its cold climate, this delivers ideal conditions for growing this variety.

With this Pinot Noir, we wanted to reveal what the first cold-climate valley planted with this variety in Chile is capable of expressing. It delivers medium-deep wines of ruby-red color, that clearly show on the nose descriptors such as strawberries and moist earth or underwood. On the palate, its tannins faithfully reflect the landscape where this wine is born, with a good entry and a persistent ending.
